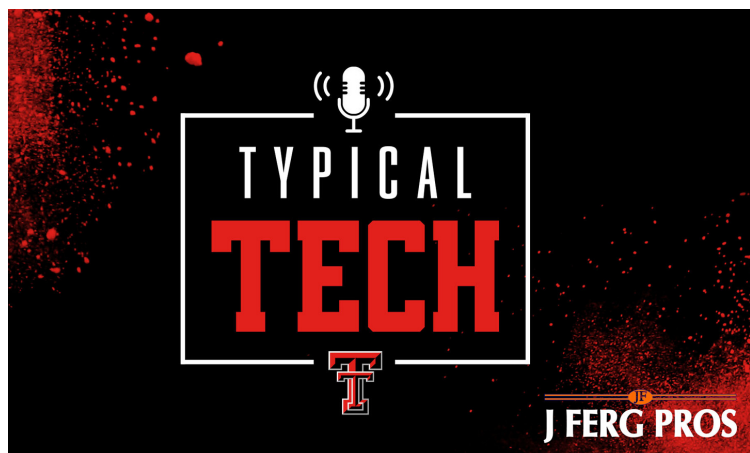

RECRUITING RULES TO REMEMBER FOR FORMER TEXAS TECH STUDENT-ATHLETES

Recruiting Basics

- A Prospective Student-Athlete (PSA) is a student who has started ninth grade and remains such until they attend classes or participate in official team practice at Texas Tech.
- All recruiting is done by designated Texas Tech head and assistant coaches.
- NCAA Rules preclude social media interactions, telephone and electronic communication and any interaction off TTU's campus.

Exception: A PSA's On-Campus Visit

- A former student-athlete MAY have on-campus contact with a PSA during the prospect's visit to campus.

After the Visit

- Additional contact with the PSA is not permitted.
- Once TexasTech.com officially announces the PSA's signing, you are permitted to have contact with the PSA. PSA's may not be provided with benefits at any time.



LETTER WINNER SPOTLIGHT TERRANCE BULLITT

TEXAS TECH FOOTBALL 2010-2013

Terrance Bullitt arrived at Texas Tech in 2009 as a three-star defensive back from Naaman Forest High School in Garland. Bullitt made his Red Raider Football debut as a redshirt freshman in 2010. In 2011 & 2012, Bullitt received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention honors for his defensive efforts. Before leaving Texas Tech, Bullitt graduated with a degree from the college of arts and sciences. Bullitt went on to continue his football career and was signed as a free agent to the Baltimore Ravens in 2014. He would later be released after failing a physical due to an ongoing injury. Bullitt's passion for football didn't stop after the NFL. Throughout the years he has been a part of the FXFL, CFL, AAS, and the XFL before permanently settling down in Rowlett, Texas last April. Bullitt now spends his days sharing his football knowledge and experience with the younger generations. Alongside his father Jerry, and his older brother Melvin (a former Texas A&M letterwinner), Bullitt has been a part of the growth and development of The Jerry Bullitt Training Center in Rowlett, Texas. Constructed in 2017, The Jerry Bullitt Training Center is a 22,000 square-foot multi-sport complex complete with volleyball courts, basketball courts, a weight room, batting cages, along with an outdoor training area and sand volleyball courts. The Bullitt Experience offers recreational and competitive sports teams, leagues, tournaments, instructional training, and youth camps. Bullitt, also the director of football, coaches athletes as young as 8 years old through juniors in high school. He also has experience training collegiate players, NFL players and has trained athletes preparing for NFL Combine. Bullitt has even trained former Red Raiders, Kerry Hyder, Branden Jackson, and Sam Eguavoen. This month, Bullitt will be celebrating the year anniversary of the creation of the Bullitt Experience football program and Bullitt7v7.
