Letter Winner Spotlight: Noel Johnson ARTICLE SUMMARY

Former Lady Raider, Noel Johnson, played for Head Coach Marsha Sharp from 1991-1995. During her time as a Lady Raider, Noel was known for her 3 point shot, setting numerous 3 point records for the program, while helping the Lady Raiders win a National Title in 1993. Following the National Title in 1993, Noel was selected by her team as MVP during the 1994 season.

Noel's success as a coach and player have been widely recognized on a state and national level. Among the list of honors, Noel is the all-time winning-est coach in Midwestern State women's basketball history, a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame, and the Texas High School Basketball Hall of Fame. She was recognized as TABC Small College Coach of the Year, and the Lone Star Conference Coach of the Year. In 2013, Noel coached Midwestern State to win the LSC Championship. Along with being a member of the 1993 National Championship Lady Raider Basketball team, Noel won back to back Texas High School State Championships during her high school career at Nazareth.

On April 2, 2019, Noel Johnson was diagnosed with ovarian cancer. Since her diagnosis, Noel has undergone multiple rounds of chemotherapy along with a surgery in June. Throughout her battle, Noel has also been raising awareness for ovarian cancer. The basketball coaching community has showed support for Noel and has helped raise awareness for ovarian cancer. Krista Gerlich, also a member of the '93 National Championship Lady Raider team & current coach of UT-Arlington, has organized an exhibition game against the Johnson-led Mustangs on Oct. 30 at 7 p.m. at College Park Center in Arlington. The game will raise money and awareness for ovarian cancer and several members of the '93 Red Raiders championship team will be in attendance, along with their Hall of Fame coach and mentor of Noel, Marsha Sharp. While she battles cancer with the same positive attitude and ferocity that she has always shown on the basketball floor, one thing remains certain. Noel Johnson will always be a winner.
